NIUE

Niue sits atop an undersea mountain with pristine clear water hundreds of metres deep just metres from shore.

Niue is affectionately known as the 'Rock of Polynesia' and is believed to be the largest coral atoll in the world. The island is located in the centre of a triangle bounded by the Cook Islands to the Southeast, Samoa in the North and Tonga to the Southwest.



CLIMATE: Niue lies in the zone of the southeast trades. Av temp from Dec - Mar is 27 degrees Celsius, April through to Nov has an average temp of 24 degrees Celsius. The weather is generally pleasant all year round.

THE MATAVAI RESORT HOTEL



The Matavai Resort Hotel has been built on the cliff side overlooking the ocean. The hotel has 24 rooms offering two queen-size beds, television, international direct dialing telephone, fridge and have air conditioning with additional ceiling fans.
